Introduction

This report has been created by CARDET to support the documentation of planning, capturing, and evaluating the local Multiplier Event (ME) of the COPE project in Cyprus.

The outcome of the Multiplier Event of the project in all partner countries (Sweden, Italy, Iceland and Cyprus) will inform the final Evaluation and Impact Analysis of the project.

In brief, the ME was completed achieving its purpose. Participants were well informed about the project purpose and objectives, the innovative aspect of the platform, and were able to have access and read the content of the e-guides (i.e., Intellectual Output 1). In addition, participants were guided to create an account in the e-learning platform of the project, test the learning resources, and give feedback. This encouraged participants to engage with the resources developed.

Implementation requirements

Within the project, CARDET completed the following implementation tasks:

1. The Multiplier Event was organized face to face. The event took place at the CyprusInno, in Nicosia, Cyprus.
2. To promote the event, a Facebook event was posted on CARDET's Facebook page and Instagram. The event has been sponsored by CARDET.
3. The event consisted of a presentation and promotional material organized by the organization's project managers, who also coordinated the event.
4. The event hosted a total of 25 participants (Annex 2). There was an increased interest in participation through the promotion, and the attendees came from various ages and organizations.

How were participants recruited and selected?	CARDET created a rooted promotional strategy using social media and other personal contacts. It created a Facebook event where it was posted on CARDET's Facebook page and Instagram. Additionally, the project manager contacted people and experts in organizations who believed that they may be interested in the event. (see Annex 3).
How was the Multiplier event planned and organised?	CARDET team created the agenda, prepared PPT presentations to introduce the project, promoted the event, provided details for registering in the e-learning platform, sent the event evaluation form to participants and offered different promotional material.
Profile of the Trainer(s) delivering the Training	Alexandros Peletie works as a project manager and researcher in CARDET. With his background in business and management, he has been involved in several projects with a focus on social entrepreneurship, sustainable development and cooperatives. His contribution lies on the scientific background and interest of the topics around education.
Highlights and positive aspects of the training implementation	During the event, participants were encouraged to raise their questions and comments. The main idea was to promote the importance of cooperatives and understanding its broad expansion in the partner countries. Also, participants were given information on how to find the needed information to use the platform.





Challenges, if any, experience during the implementation and how they were managed	The main challenge relied on the fact that because it was in the holiday season, not all participants came the same time. Nonetheless, some participants who arrived late stayed later and received the information they missed at the beginning.
Summary of feedback from Tutor	The event was conducted with success. The main issue for improvement was to have some more flexibility for the people who may not arrive in time and may provide a hybrid option for those who prefer to participate online.

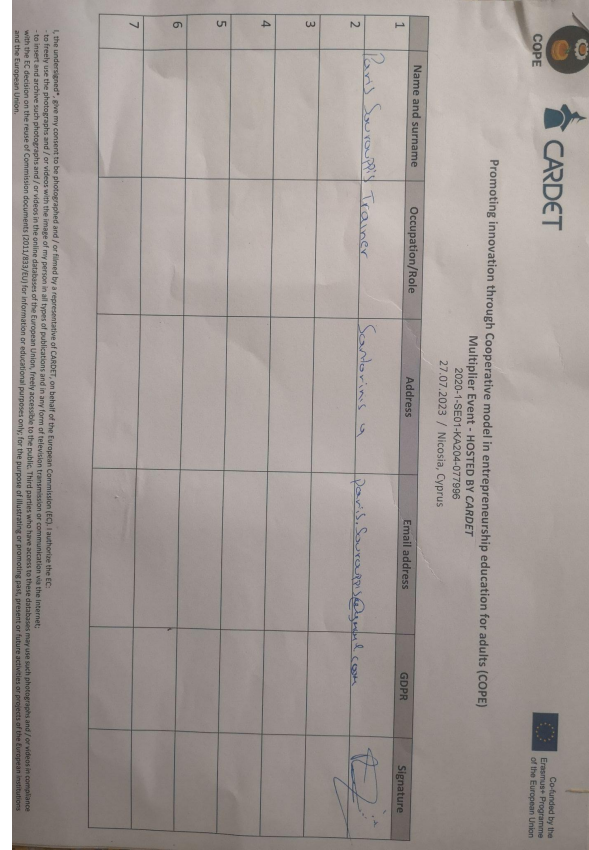
